POLICY BULLETIN NO. 88

SUBJECT: Discontinuance of Service

POLICY:

The Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue service without notice or with reasonable notice for violation of any of the Cooperative's policies, procedures, rate schedules, contract provisions, or other just cause.

RESPONSIBILITY:

General Manager

PROCEDURE:

1. Without Notice - The Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue the supply of electric service to any Member without notice for any of the following reasons:

- a) For any disapproval of a Member's equipment or wiring installation due to safety defects or hazardous conditions.
- b) For repairs or emergency operations.
- c) For unavoidable shortage or interruption of the Cooperative's source of energy or demand.
- d) Upon cancellation of a contract and/or vacating of the premises by the Member.
- e) For any tampering with any service wires, meters, seals, or any other facilities belonging to the Cooperative which upon discovery are in the opinion of the Cooperative unsafe or which present a hazardous condition.

2. After Reasonable Notice - The Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue service, after reasonable notice, as determined by the Cooperative to the Member, for any of the following reasons:

- a) For fraudulent representation as to the use of electric service.

- b) For tampering with any service wires, meters, seals, or any other facilities belonging to the Cooperative.
- c) When necessary to protect the Cooperative from theft, fraud, or abuse.
- d) For refusal of giving reasonable access to the Member's property to an employee of the Cooperative for the purpose of inspecting and/or maintaining the Cooperative's facilities or for installing or removing, reading, maintaining or testing the Cooperative's meters.
- e) For the use of equipment which adversely affects the Cooperative's service to its other Members.
- f) For violation of any of the Cooperative's policies, procedures, or any other applicable rules and regulations.

The discontinuance of service for any of these causes does not release the Member from their obligation to pay for energy received, or the charges specified in any existing contract.

3. Restoration of Service - The Cooperative will restore service when the causes of discontinuance have been removed and payment of any and all charges due the Cooperative has been made.
